The time that you are outside the hotel you can follow the next recommendations to fit in in the community

- We ask you to be careful with your belongings in the touristic areas so you cannot have problems with the pickpockets
- Please consider give a donation of food to the accommodation or a local charity in the surroundings.
- We ask you to not participate in activities such as take pictures on the street with animals.
- Do not listen the excursion offers of people in the street.
- We want to explain in this guide also the protected areas that are nearby you.

-The Dunes of Maspalomas is a unique natural space in the Canary Islands for its beauty and the variety of ecosystems it has. Protected by the Government of the Canary Islands as a special nature reserve, its 400 hectares encompass an excellent beach, a field of live sand dunes and a forest of palm trees. This

mixture of desert and oasis is located on the coast of the extreme south of Gran Canaria and is surrounded by the famous hotel establishments of the great tourist resort of Maspalomas.

-Also recommended to visit the Jardín Canario in the road of Tafira Alta, where you can see all the endemic Canarian vegetation.

-Hardly recommended to visit the Cocodrilo Park Gran Canaria, in Carretera Los Corralillos , km 5.5 Agüimes.

According to Washington agreement signed by Spain in 1987, it should be a place that accommodated animals that has been stolen or coming from the illegal traffic of animals. With your entry to the park you contribute to keep these animals and in Gran Canaria, we have a wide variety of animal species.
